During the previous week, a 'Battle of the Bands' competition was held between the KS2 classes - they competed against each other on times table speed and accuracy. Year 5 were successful in winning the overall battle! Many children were recognised for their efforts in the challenge and received certificates in the assembly at the end of the day.
