Dear parent/ carer,

The teachers worked together to look at maths books this week. We were really impressed by the coverage in every class, the range of activities the children had experienced, the use of concrete resources and practical activities to support understanding, the opportunity for challenge and the beautiful presentation in books: it was so clear to see how much care and effort the children put into their work and the progress they are making.

We could see the positive impact of teaching maths in single age groups in upper key stage two and have decided to extend this to lower key stage two. From Monday, year 3 maths will be taught by Mrs Thompson and Mrs Lockwood, year 4 maths will be taught by Mrs Todd and Mrs Jones, year 5 maths will be taught by Mrs Bradley and year 6 maths will be taught by Miss Dickenson.

Yorkshire Learning Trust Video

Some of our children were involved in recording their thoughts about school for a Yorkshire Learning Trust video which will be shared at the Trust's Belonging and Mattering conference on Friday 24th October (remember school will be closed for children on this day). They did a great job in front of the camera!

We are so proud of all of our pupils and it was lovely to hear the different things they had to say about our school. Areas of enjoyment and praise from the children included reading in school, maths lessons, drawing in art, our new playtime areas for OPAL and learning the ukulele in music.

When asked to describe our school in one word, KS2 pupils described it as "fun!", "inclusive" and "amazing" - we don't think it gets much better than that!

Yousafzai Class


Yousafzai class have been practising their shading and sketching skills. They have been drawing European landmarks and practising how to shade in details for 3D objects.

Garden Trees Scheme (with a sneaky shrub!)

For our 5th Garden Trees Scheme, we're keeping our roots in Dunnington but branching out even further to our neighbouring villages of Holtby, Warthill, Stockton-on-the-Forest and, for the first time, Osbaldwick!

For those concerned about space, we're sneaking in a shrub! To celebrate National Tree Week, GIG's offering 5 buzz-bringing beauties: Crab Apple, with sweet-smelling, pinky-white blossom and small yellow fruits loved by birds; Pear, a favourite with wildlife with attractive autumn leaf colour; Hawthorn, a biodiversity champion supporting over 300 insects; Elder, which can be pruned as a shrub; and Wild Cherry, with essential early nectar for bees emerging from their winter sleep.


