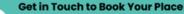

# **Nighttime Wetting**

Video Guide for Children, Young People and Families

This video has been developed by a team of healthcare professionals to help you understand the possible causes of bed-wetting as well as sharing some simple strategies you can try at home and school. It also provides advice on what to do if you have tried the strategies and it's still an issue. It provides guidance for children, young people and families which is suitable for all children and young people, of any age, with advice that can be adapted for children and young people with physical or learning needs.

Remember, bed-wetting is not the parent, carer or child's fault and there is lots of advice and support available.
