There is still time to donate on Parentpay if you have not done so already: We have received £229.50 so far and the cost of the visit is £300.

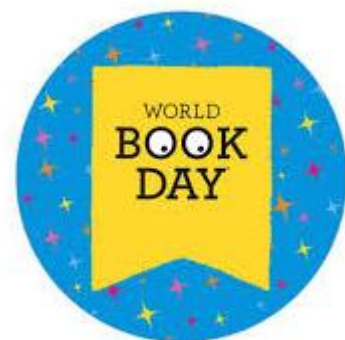
Junior Leadership Team

Asthma Friendly School Award



We are in the process of becoming an Asthma Friendly School. The award was set up as a health improvement project for children with asthma as the UK has the worst health outcomes for children with asthma in Europe.

This week, an asthma nurse attended school to check our asthma register and start the process of ensuring all children with asthma have Personalised Asthma Plans. He also spoke to parents/carers and offered advice to ensure that their asthma was managed effectively and appropriately.

In the summer term, staff will receive training to ensure that they are skilled and confident to support a child with asthma if they are having any difficulties.

We will keep you updated and let you know when we achieve the award.

Well done to the children who were given Numbots and TTRS certificates this week.



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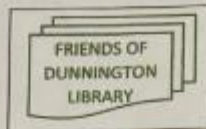
